(17.01.2020) One-day excursion to Indian National Museum, Kolkata





Migratory Bird watching at Santragachi Jheel: a one-day trip (18.02.2023)

A one-day program on watching migratory birds was organized by the ECO-CLUB of Department of Zoology, Shyampur Siddheswari Mahavidyalya in collaboration with Nature Mates Nature Club at Santragachi Jheel on the 18th of this month. To attend that program, a short trip was arranged by the Nature Club of Department of Zoology, Sovarani Memorial College. Prime objective of that program was to introduce the winged visitors of the Santragachi Jheel to the fellow participants. The organizers provided good quality binoculars and high resolution cameras to spot some of the rare migratory birds, came from both distant and nearby locations. They extended a sincere assistance and guidance to the fellow participants to learn how to recognize a bird with the help of its body shape, size, color of feathers, wing span, call and behavior. A brief idea on the timing of onset of both forward and backward journey, purpose of the migration and the mechanism of navigation during migration of each bird that came to that mentioned Jheel was also provided by the organizers. Finally, they highlighted the present status of bird migration to the Santragachi Jheel. Based on continuous observation they opined that the number and variety of birds, migrating to the Jheel every year is reducing alarmingly due to some anthropogenic activities and some other unrevealed reasons. They also added that concerned authorities have not taken any effective measures to solve that serious problem still now.



World Wildlife Day Celebration (03.03.2023)

This year our department celebrated the 50th World Wildlife day. The teachers, students of the department and Principal of the college were present in the program. At first Principal, Dr. Kalyan Kumar Mondal, gave a short speech appreciating the efforts in conducting the program.
