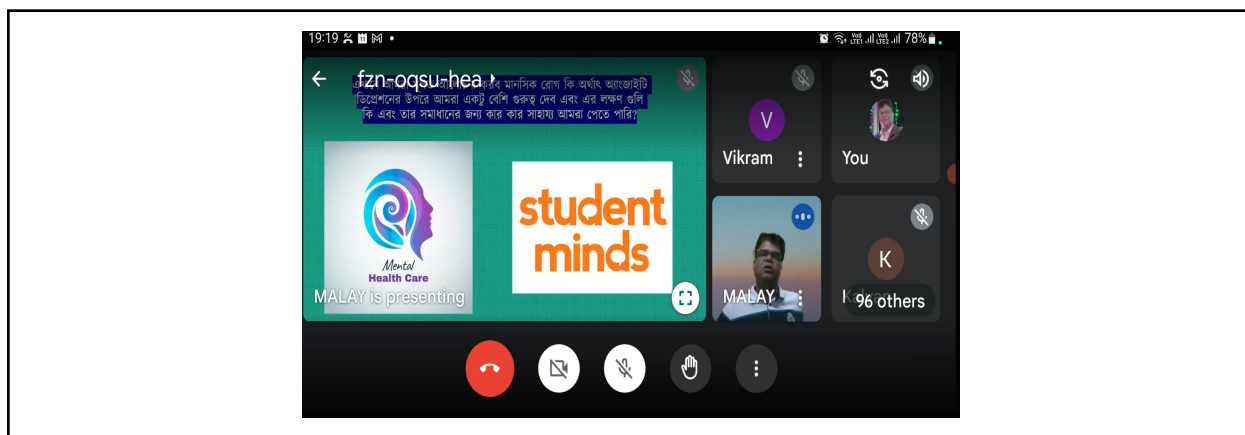
❖ OBSERVATION OF WORLD MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS DAY

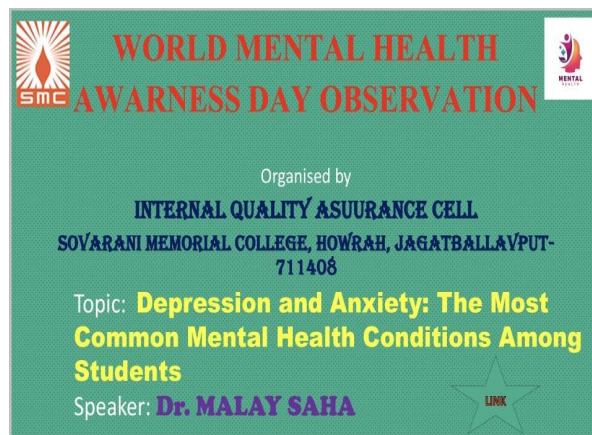
In collaboration with IQAC of College, Dr Malay Saha, Department of Botany delivered an online awareness speech on ***“Depression and Anxiety: The Most Common Mental Health Conditions Among Students”*** The goal of the mental awareness seminar was to help participants learn about and understand mental health, so that they can better support themselves and others.

Topics covered in the seminar included:

- *What is mental health?*
- *The signs and symptoms of common mental health disorders among college students.*
- *Risk factors for developing mental health problems.*
- *How to get help for oneself or someone else who is struggling with mental health issues?*

Dr. Saha, in his lecture, provided practical tools and resources for coping with mental health challenges. This included information on where to find support, how to take care of oneself, and how to reduce stress. More than 100 participants including college faculty staff and students participated in this seminar and a short interactive session was also conducted.

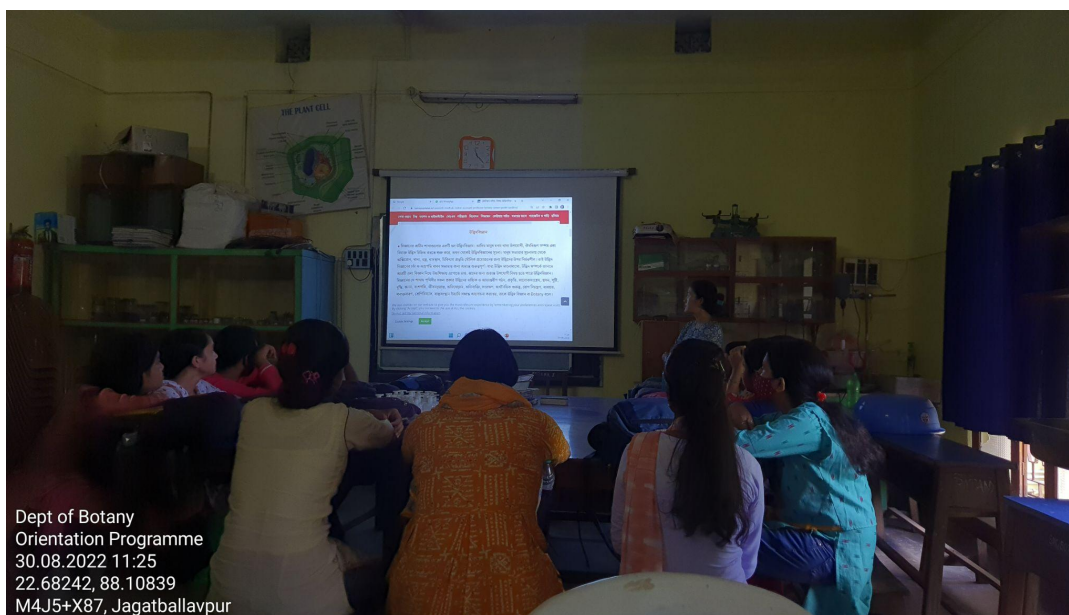




❖ DEPARTMENTAL ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
