questionnaire in google form from the parents of the children. Data reveals that more than 90% households do not adopt any technique to purify the drinking water at

household level. Nearly 40% of households suffer from waterborne diseases in the last five years. Jaundice was one of the most happening diseases. more than 45% of households are from Muslim community. Most of the remaining households are from the scheduled tribe/schedule caste category.

Also more than 90% of people

do not have any idea about the technique and importance of drinking water purification. Most of them depend on tube well water supply for drinking. School headmaster helped a lot in conducting the program successfully.
