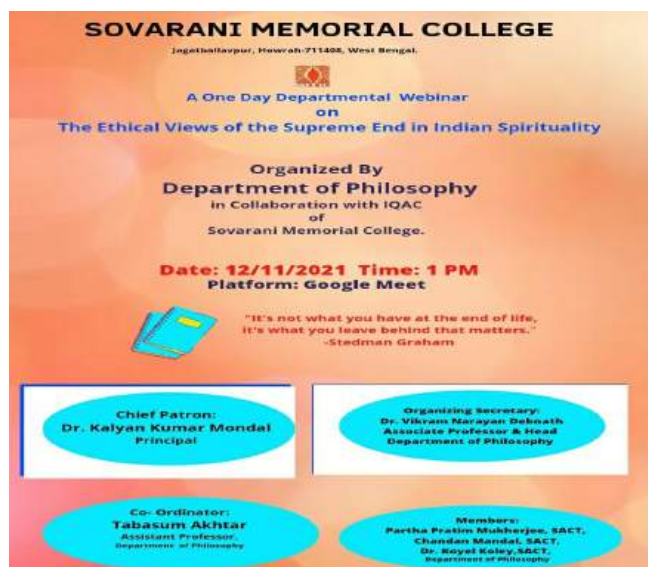

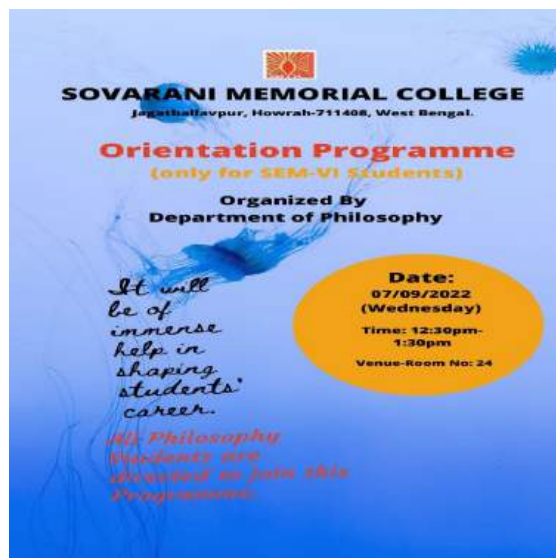

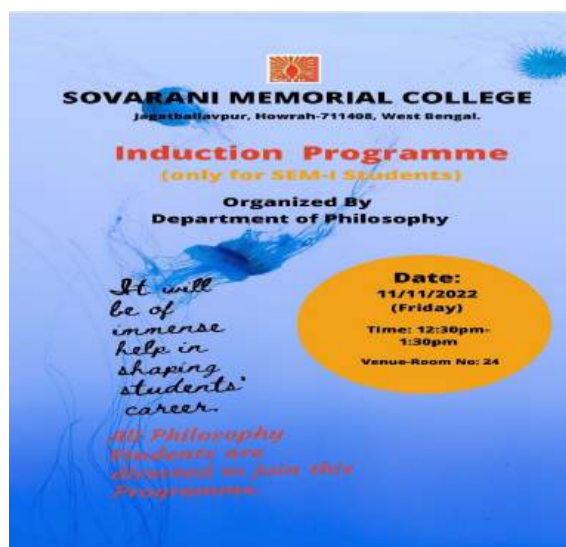
Event Objective:
